





in the scale of the two operations, they are in their way as significant. Throughout the last weeks of October and the first weeks of November, when victory was still hanging in the balance, an uninterrupted stream of intelligence from D-10 supplemented by JN#4, flowed out to the fleet. On 30 October the Communications Intelligence Unit received a commendation from Admiral King. It came at the end of a month of successes, of which the battles of Cape Esperance (11 October) and Santa Cruz (26 October) were the most outstanding. The crucial battle of Guadalcanal (13-14-15 November) resulted in a defeat costing the enemy 2 BB's, 4 CA's, 4 DD's and a number of transports, more than 20,000 Japanese troops losing their lives in the sinking of the convoy. The last major attempt to recapture the island had been broken. On 17 November the unit was commended by Admiral Himitz, and Admiral King appended a "Well Done".

Usage No. 1 was in effect from 15 August 1942 to 14 April 1943, and the period was marked by almost continuous decryption and increasingly speedy break-ins when ciphers changed. When Usage No. 2 went into effect on 15 April, JN#25 was to undergo a 37-day black-out, for Usage No. 2 was not to be as quickly solved as No. 1 had been. In view of this, the following E-14 despatch of two days before, 13 April, may be said to have been sent just in time:
